BEEMAN RECALL

Beeman Precision Arms, Inc., announces a voluntary recall of all Beeman HW 70 air pistols distributed and sold by the company. It has been determined that a very small number of these air pistols have developed a condition in which the gun may discharge when the action is snapped shut after cocking; however, the company has not received any reports of any injuries due to accidental discharge.

Anyone in possession of HW 70 pistols is advised not to sell or use them until the sear has been replaced with a new different factory unit. The new sears are expected late in May, 1984.

Owners and dealers of HW 70s sold or distributed by Beeman should send them to Beeman, Inc., Dept. HW 70, 47 Paul Drive, San Rafael, CA 94903. Beeman will rebuild guns free of charge in the United States (foreign—add \$20 for shipping and handling).
